- The Our REACH™ app, with AI, further engages participants, staff & mentors/ coaches, by providing a mobile, collaborative platform for any program curriculum, plus personalized milestone "road-maps," custom-made resources & communication in crucial life skill arenas

New Jersey Corrections

- ~\$74K/incarcerated person in FY25 budget
- Initiatives to reduce recidivism are occurring
- Many individuals leaving jail/prison struggle with substance use
- Over 60% nationally of formerly incarcerated people are unemployed 1 year after release
- Reentering people also face housing challenges
- Case mgmt is a large part of reentry expense

The Challenge

- Reentering people thrive on outside at a much higher rate
- Efficiency improves for reentry program staff & volunteers
- Recidivism becomes lower, therefore reducing cost of Corrections

Reentering participants receive app for free



Work with reentering people so they can thrive; may have volunteer/staff shortages & feel stressed.

Struggle with Social Drivers of Health (SDoHs): housing, jobs, education, food insecurity; may have substance use issues

- INSIDE JAIL/PRISON: Introduce program & app when participants are preparing to leave facility; participants choose "milestones" on which they want to focus; participants & coaches/mentors can meet & begin forming relationships
- AFTER RELEASE: Once participants return to the community, they receive "live app" & continue to work on their "milestones" (with associated resources) on their own & in communicating with coaches/mentors

Challenges

Results from using OurREACH™

Participant

- Ella is in prison, awaiting reentry
- She left high school when Alexa was born; her mom is caring for Alexa & she'll move back home with them
 - · Lacks financial management skills
 - · Needs job training
 - Anxious about utilizing technology
- Ella gets training on the app while preparing to leave prison & learns about setting goals
- She develops a reentry plan with her mentor
- Once back home, she receives the app, gets her GED & job training, & finds a stable job
- Achieves goals to increase financial freedom
- Easy-to-use trusted mobile app with rewards motivates Ella to develop new habits

Reentry Staff & Volunteers

- - Mia is a staff member at a job training program
 - Ava is a volunteer Mentor, stressed with serving reentering people with varying needs Mia & Ava have difficulty communicating with Ella, each other, & others between mtgs They want to effectively share SDoH resources
- Use app to align w/job training curric
- Communicate more easily with Ella to encourage her & with others to coordinate
- With AI companion in app, smoothly point to actionable SDoH resources & relevant milestones
- Nimbly support participants individually & in groups; app saves time

Reentry Program or Coalition



- Lacks real-time data on participants' progress
- Needs more staff/volunteer coordination
- Faces staff shortages & financial crunches
- Concerned about recidivism
- Concerned about technical inter-operability
- Tracks each participant's granular progress
- Staff/volunteers save time & coordinate better
- Participant engagement boosts program effectiveness & attractiveness to donors
- Improved outcomes lead to lower recidivism
- Smooth integration with existing tools
